GUIDELINES - WEIGHING NORDIC FOLKBOATS IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 10 N.F.I.A INTERNATIONAL CLASS RULES 2017

RULE 10: WEIGHT OF NORDIC FOLKBOAT

'10.10 The weight of the boat shall not be less than 1930 kg. weighed complete with floorboards, pumps, seats, and all fittings normally used on board whilst racing, together with the following:

Mast and boom (without whisker pole and/or spinnaker pole) with all their fittings, standing rigging, halyards and sheets for the mainsail.

The equipment included in the weight of not less than 1930 kg shall not thereafter be removed whilst racing and shall be in its normal position whilst racing; e.g the helmsman's seat.'

In essence when a boat is weighed it should <u>only</u> comprise. <u>Everything not mentioned</u> below should come off:

Complete and dry Hull and Deck
Floorboards, Pumps, Seats including Helmsman's Seat and all fittings
normally on board when racing
Mast and Boom including fittings
Standing Rigging
Halyards
Mainsheet
Correctors

CHECK:

ARE BILGES DRY?
ARE DRAWERS, SHELVES, LOCKERS EMPTY?
IS BATTERY REMOVED?
MOORING WARPS, FENDERS REMOVED?
HELMSMAN'S SEAT ONBOARD?
OUTBOARD BRACKET CAN REMAIN - ALLOWANCE TO
BE MADE
